The donor walls at Episcopal Senior Communities communities recognize the generosity of our donors. Gifts to the ESC general fund are encouraged, but all contributors have the option of designating their gifts to a particular ESC community. Outright contributions can frequently be put to use immediately. Generosity expressed through deferred gifts such as wills, living trusts, insurance policies, retirement plans, or charitable trusts are equally appreciated and often enable a donor to receive significant tax and income benefits. ESC Honor Roll of Giving Cumulative Lifetime Gifts

Friend	\$5,000 - \$9,999
Sponsor	\$10,000 – \$49,999
Benefactor	\$50,000 – \$99,999
Patron	\$100,000 - \$499,999
Founder	over \$500,000
